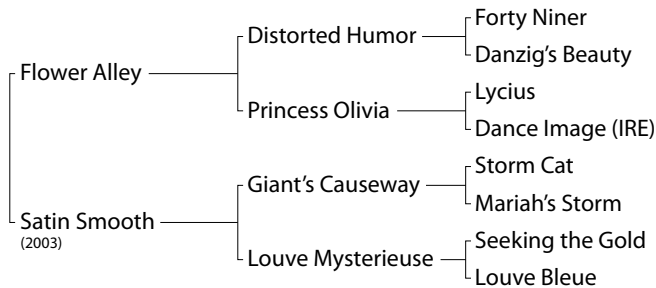




Vintage 2010 · Flower Alley filly

By **FLOWER ALLEY** (2002). Black-type winner of \$2,533,910, Travers S. [G1] (SAR, \$600,000), Jim Dandy S. [G2] (SAR, \$300,000), Lane's End S. [G2] (TP, \$300,000), Salvator Mile S. [G3] (MTH, \$90,000), 2nd Breeders' Cup Classic [G1] (BEL, \$936,000), Arkansas Derby [G2] (OP, \$200,000), Dwyer S. [G2] (BEL, \$30,000). **His first foals are 2-year-olds of 2010.** Son of black-type winner Distorted Humor, among the leading sires, sire of 81 black-type winners, 3 champions, including Funny Cide [G1] (11 wins).

SATIN SMOOTH, by Giant's Causeway. Unraced. Dam of 1 other registered foal, none of racing age.

LOUVE MYSTERIEUSE, by Seeking the Gold. 2 wins at 3, €32,472, in France, Prix Madame Jean Couturie; winner at 5, \$89,736, in N.A./U.S. (Total: \$123,891). Dam of 3 other foals, 2 winners--

TRUE QUALITY (c. by Elusive Quality). 5 wins at 3 and 4, 2009, \$288,178, General George H. [G2] (LRL, \$90,000), Paumonok H. (AQU, \$41,598), 2nd Gravesend H. [G3] (AQU, \$21,782), 3rd Woody Stephens S. [G2] (BEL, \$25,000), Adjudicating S. (BEL, \$7,660).

Louve Bleue, by Irish River (FR). Winner at 3, €44,439, in France, 2nd Prix Saint-Alary [G1]; winner at 4, \$44,150, in N.A./U.S., 3rd Yerba Buena H. [L] (GG, \$22,500). (Total: \$93,909). Sister to **LASCAUX**. Dam of 5 winners, incl.--

LOUVE MYSTERIEUSE. Black-type winner, above.

4th dam

***LUPE II**, by Primera. 6 wins, 2 to 4 in England, champion older mare, Epsom Oaks, Cheshire Oaks, Coronation Cup, etc. Half-sister to **ALCAN**, ***Les Baux**, **Bless the Squire**. Dam of 10 foals, 9 to race, 8 winners, incl.--

LASCAUX. 3 wins at 3, €76,818, in France, Prix Jean de Chaudenay [G2]. (Total: \$ 79,415). Sire.

LOUVETERIE. Winner at 2 and 3, €157,793, in France, Prix Vanteaux [G3], etc. (Total: \$172,979). Dam of **LOUP**

SAUVAGE [G1] (Total: \$902,710, hwt. 3 times in Europe and France, sire), **LOUP SOLITAIRE** [G1] (Total: \$251,015, hwt. colt at 2 on French Hand.), **LOUVE** [G3] (dam of **LOUP BRETON (IRE)** [G2], Total: \$626,014; **LOUVE ROYALE (IRE)** [L]).

LEONARDO DA VINCI (FR). 2 wins in 4 starts at 3 in England, White Rose S.-G3; 2 wins in 4 starts at 4, \$38,350, in N.A./U.S. Sire.

L'ILE DU REVE. 2 wins in 4 starts at 3 in England, Cheshire Oaks-G3.

LEGEND OF FRANCE. 3 wins at 3 and 4 in England, Earl of Sefton S.-G3.



This exquisite filly is by freshman sire Flower Alley and a Giant's Causeway mare. On the racetrack Flower Alley won the G1 Travers Stakes (by 2.5 lengths), the G2 Jim Dandy Stakes (by 5.25 lengths), the G2 Lane's End Stakes, and the G3 Salvatore Mile (by 3.25 lengths). He ran second in the G1 Breeders Cup Classic losing to Saint Liam, second in the G2 Arkansas Derby, and second in the G2 Dwyer Stakes. He banked over \$2.5 million in earnings.

Flower Alley's sire is Distorted Humor. Distorted Humor was the #2 nationally ranked sire in 2009 and he's currently the #4 nationally ranked sire in 2010. Distorted Humor has sired Funny Cide (\$3,529,412), Hystericalady (\$2,390,556), Commentator (\$2,049,845), Regal Ransom (\$1,747,200), Hello Pretty (AUS) (\$1,205,529), and Any Given Saturday (\$1,083,533) among many others.

Our filly's broodmare sire is Giant's Causeway. Giant's Causeway was the #1 nationally ranked sire in 2009 and he's currently the #1 nationally ranked sire in 2010. Giant's Causeway is a multiple Group 1 winner in Europe and was named Horse of the Year in Europe and Champion 3-Year-Old Colt in both England and France. Giant's Causeway has sired recent Kentucky Derby early favorite Eskendereya.

This filly is by a freshman sire that had one of the best successes on the racetrack. Her sire's sire is currently nationally ranked #4 and her dam's sire is currently nationally ranked #1. There are graded stakes up and down both sides of her pedigree and she has the potential to be any kind of horse. She's a very correct, good sized filly with plenty of leg and scope.
